WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

ACCOMMODATIONS: Basecamp is located at Tony's house, with room to set up your tent and includes hot showers & bathrooms.

FOOD & WATER: All meals during the House Build will be provided, as well as Purified drinking water.

SKILL: We prefer you have more love than skill. No previous experience required. This trip accommodates all ages and skill levels.

TRAVEL: We will meet at a specified location and caravan into Mexico. Mexico Car Insurance is REQUIRED for all vehicles.

PASSPORTS are required.

SCHEDULE OUTLINE (subject to change based on group)

Day 1: Meet at for final instructions, travel by caravan, estimated arrival in Rocky Point will be 4 hours with a WELCOME MEETING at basecamp.

Day 2: We will gather for breakfast & devotion @ 7:30am. We will then depart to worksite to meet the family & begin construction.

Day 3: We will repeat Day 2. The evening will end with a Fiesta Night celebration with the family and locals.

Day 4: We will add a Wrap Up Meeting after breakfast, complete the house, give the family the keys & pray.

THE PROJECT

We will be constructing a simple 11' x 22' home. Children are encouraged to participate in the construction process. All of the construction will be completed with the hand tools. We will be working alongside the homeowner & strive to include extended family, friends & neighbors. The floor is cement mixed by hand. The walls & roof will be a 2" x 4" construction. The exterior of the home is finished with stucco.

SAFETY

While in Mexico, each participant will travel in groups & agrees not to participate in activities that could jeopardize their safety or the safety of others.
